UNCONTESTED DIVORCE



Thank you for the opportunity to consult with you regarding your legal matter. As a LegalShieldSM member, you should never hesitate to contact us when any legal questions or concerns arise. In order to access your benefits under the Uncontested Divorce benefits provision of your LegalShield contract, you will need to provide Framme Law Firm with a financial disclosure statement for each spouse and a written statement that includes the following:

The statement must include a sentence that says that all marital assets, including your home if you have one, total no more than \$500,000.00.

The statement must include a sentence that says there are no retirement benefits that need to be divided.

The statement must include a sentence that says all matters between the parties have been resolved and agreed to. The resolved matters include, but are not limited to, all matters related to child custody, child support, alimony and the division of all marital assets.

The statement must include a sentence that states that all of the information contained in the statement is true, correct and accurate. If any information is found to be incorrect and/or has been misrepresented by either party, the matter will no longer be considered an "Uncontested Divorce" but will be determined to be a "Contested Divorce" and you will have to pay for any further legal services under the preferred member discount rates.

The statement must include a sentence that neither party is represented by an attorney nor will either party retain an attorney. Once either party retains an attorney, the matter will no longer be considered an "Uncontested Divorce" but will be determined to be a "Contested Divorce" and you will have to pay for any further legal services under the preferred member discount rates.

The statement must be signed by both parties and the original document forwarded to our offices. The statement will need to be notarized.

Finally, the member must send a check or money order in the amount of \$150.00 to cover filing fees and court costs. Any unused funds will be refunded to the member.

Finally, please be advised that you will be responsible to pay all the court filing fees as well as any other costs required by the court. The attorney handling your case will advise you of the amount of fees/costs required to file your case. You should be prepared to pay those monies upon request of the attorney handling your case. Failure to pay any requested court costs and/or filing fees in a timely manner will result in the non-completion of your file.
